### Fred Hill Shock – weather is good!

Over the past twelve years we've had snow, sleet and ice. We've had gale force winds and the rain dancing off the cobbles in the Cathedral precinct. I've felt the notes for the reading turning into papier-mache in my hands. But this year the sun shone on Fred Hill. This year also marked the first time we

have not started the run from the old Napier pub in Blackburn, home to Red Rose MAG for over a decade. The Sir Charles Napier was a Blackburn landmark, a real biker bar in its day, but it has now gone the way of so many other pubs in recent years. Its closure adds yet one more nail into the coffin of Blackburn town centre, which has gone from one of the most vibrant in the North West to almost a ghost town at night. Many people blame the policies of successive governments for failing to support the pub trade but this has fallen on deaf ears of those in power. The sad fact is that many of those passing the laws never set foot in a pub. If they close, then it is of little concern to them personally. What, though, has all this got to do with Fred Hill?

As bikers we are a vulnerable minority in more ways than one – not only on the road but also vulnerable to interfering legislation, albeit well-meant, sponsored by the non-biking majority. They sit in judgement, decreeing what is an acceptable risk and what is not, knowing that the repercussions of their laws will never affect them directly. MAG, however, believes that the best people to make decisions about personal safety on motorcycles are those who ride them. We know the risks, we know the consequences and we can weigh them up for ourselves. This is what Fred Hill believed and this



is what, in the end, he gave his life for. He believed that whether he wore a crash helmet or not was of no concern to anyone else. Therefore, on principle, he refused to wear one. This was his own choice and he didn't try to dictate to anyone else what they should do. When he was arrested and convicted (as he was many times!) he refused to pay the fines. In response they locked him up, an old man and not in the best of health. 32 years ago this year he died in prison.

Each year, around the anniversary of his death, bikers the length and breadth of the UK gather in small ceremonies to pause and remember Fred. True to his spirit, we will continue the fight for riders' rights.






