A Political Party set up by bikers for bikers (and anyone else who values freedom of choice)

New M.A.P. Chairman Blayz writes:

The Motorcycle Alliance Party is a new national political party representing the core values of the biker community in the political arena. Founded in February 2012 the aim of the party was to field a candidate in the upcoming Greater Manchester Police Commissioner Election in November 2012. This election was chosen specifically because of the sometimes harsh and discriminatory policing methods employed by Greater Manchester Police towards bikers, including restricting movement, abusing power and misusing legal tools such as ASBO's. Bikers in the Greater Manchester area had even been prevented from attending funerals by their local police, an act that was felt to be unjustifiable in a civilized country. However, the election rules were changed which meant that we were unable to field a suitable candidate.



The current party leadership is:

The party is not just concerned with bikers however, and supports freedom for all citizens of the UK, and the right to choose how to live their lives, as long as their actions do not negatively impact on the freedom and rights of others. Membership requires that you hold, or have held, the legal ability to ride a motorcycle, (including scooters trike or quad-bike).

Our Mission Statement is:

To bring about a fair and lawful society, where all, including Police Officers, will be equal within the law and not act in a manner that discriminates against any group or individual due to the mode of transport they choose.

To be brought about via lawful demonstrations, meetings and election of members to political positions including that of Commissioner of Police, Local Councillor and MP.

So, why do we need our own political party? After all, there are plenty of traditional political parties out there: Labour, Conservative, UKIP, Liberal Democrats and Green Party to name just some in the mainstream. If you are a member of any of the political parties, just ask yourselves, what have they done for bikers like you? Do they listen to your concerns and more importantly, do they act on them?

I suspect that the general answer would be no, although MAG is making very good inroads into some local governments and some parts of national government with the introduction of biker friendly policies such as allowing bikes into bus lanes. However, it is only in certain areas of the country where the local government has started to listen to what its constituents want and not across the whole of the UK.

So why am I writing this? First of all, did you know that bikers had their own party? Secondly what would it take for YOU to join?

The answer to the first question is now you do know about us. The answer to the second question lies with you. We want active members, bikers who are willing to stick their necks out (a little bit) and put themselves forward in local elections to support their local (biking) communities and freedom of choice for all, It cost nothing to do but the Motorcycle Alliance Party emblem appears next to your name on the ballot paper. (imagine the leverage this could bring). Should you actually win an election, it's your choice whether you wish to continue, however you would have the full support of the Party, naturally, and hopefully the rest of the biking community in your local area.

It's a start and with your support we can grow into a major force in this country. Just a thought, if every biker voted for a member of its own political party we could change the face of politics in this country.

I don't do politics, I hear some of you say, well unfortunately for you, politics works for or against you, on your behalf whether you like it or not. Why not get on board and help influence policy decision making in your neck of the woods?

The Motorcycle Alliance Party is an avid supporter of MAG and the majority of its party members are also members of MAG.

Key London Mayoral Candidates Share Motorbike Views with MAG

MAG has secured statements from the two front running candidates in the race to become Mayor of London. Sadiq Khan MP (Labour) and Zac Goldsmith MP (Conservative) shared with MAG their thoughts and plans for the capital's hundreds of thousands of qualified motorcycle and scooter riders - and both have expressed their appreciation of the importance of powered two wheelers as part of the London transport mix, promising to work to ensure their needs are taken into account.

MAG's Chair Selina Lavender, very encouraged by their responses, said: "MAG is not party political, we engage with members of all parties with a view to assisting riders in making an informed decision between leading candidates. As either Zac or Sadiq are tipped to win this election, we invited them to outline how they see motorcycles in the context of London Transport policy (as neither had done so prior to our involvement)... riders haven't always felt they've enjoyed a level playing field with other road users. Hundreds of millions of pounds have been spent on making cycling safer. All we're asking for is consideration for our needs too and recognition of the importance of motorbikes and scooters in our ever more congested city. I'm heartened by the responses of both these front-running candidates. MAG can and will work with the winner. We leave it to the motorcycle and scooter riders of London to vote to decide who that should be."

So why does this concern us, up here in the North-West? Well, we all know that what happens in the capital sets a precedent for the rest of the country. If MAG can establish biker-friendly policies down there, it'll make our jobs easier up here.
