Loud "acoustic vehicle alert systems" save lives



Research has shown that pedestrians are more likely to be hit by an electric or hybrid vehicle simply because they're too quiet to hear them approaching (plus being glued to a phone when they should be looking doesn't help). So next month new regulations will require manufacturers to install artificial sound generators on electric vehicles from 2021. This will apply in the UK even after Brexit because we are still committed to aligning vehicle specs across Europe. Can mine sound like a Panther please?

Farewell flat tyres?

The "Uptis" tyre (Unique Punctureproof Tire System) being developed by Michelin and General Motors is a revolutionary airless tyre made with a form of fibreglass and aluminium which could be available on the road within the next five years. A series of spokes replaces the usual sidewall on the tyre to bear the car's weight at high speeds and prevent the possibility of a blowout.

The technology is designed to be tougher than conventional tyres, avoiding dangerous blowouts while minimising friction to improve fuel



economy. They are also supposed to be cheaper and longer-lasting than conventional inflated tyres. According to the companies, the new tyre could also be 3D printed, making it quicker to produce. There seems to be no word as yet whether the technology can be applied to motorcycles.

Over the barrel for batteries.

The UK risks being "held to ransom" over cobalt and other minerals needed for the batteries for electric vehicles because a small number of unstable countries control the supply. It has been calculated that meeting the country's 2035 target for electric vehicles would require the import of almost as much cobalt as is consumed by the whole of European industry and total global cobalt production would have to more than triple to convert all vehicles in the world to electricity by 2050. More than 60 per cent of the world's supply

of cobalt comes from the extremely dodgy Democratic Republic of Congo, where production is controlled by Chinese traders (partly relying on child labour and workers can be paid as little as 50p a day). This would leave the country vulnerable to embargoes and other stoppages in supply.


